Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by Council District.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between Council Districts are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus three percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (814 completed surveys). For each Council District (Central, Northwest, Northwest, Southeast and Southwest), the margin of error rises to approximately plus or minus nine percentage points since sample sizes were approximately 143 for the Central District, 113 for the Northeast, 146 for the Northwest, 205 for the Southeast and 207 for the Southwest. Notable differences between Council Districts included the following:

- Within the pillar of Community Characteristics, survey participants who lived in the Southeast District were more likely to give excellent or good ratings to the availability of walking paths and trails in Sioux Falls than residents from other areas of the City. K-12 education received lower marks from respondents who lived in the Central District. The neighborliness of Sioux Falls residents received more positive ratings from respondents in the Southeast and Southwest Council Districts than respondents form other areas of the City.
- Residents' ratings for Sioux Falls' services and amenities and the City's leadership and governance were generally similar between Council Districts; however, there were a few noteworthy exceptions. Residents of the Southeast and Southwest Districts tended to more favorably rate the value of services for the taxes paid to the City. Sioux Falls' emergency preparedness received lower ratings from residents of the Central and the Northwest Districts, and preservation of natural areas received lower ratings from respondents from the Central and Northeast areas of the City. Finally, individuals from the Northwest were less likely to give excellent or good ratings to public information services than residents from other Council Districts.
- Within the pillar of Participation, respondents who lived in the Northeast and Northwest Council Districts tended to give lower ratings to the sense of community in Sioux Falls than participants in other Districts. Respondents from the Central District were more likely to have walked or biked instead of driving in the 12 months prior to the survey than their counterparts; however, these same residents were less likely to be optimistic that the economy would have a positive impact on their income in the coming six months.
- When asked about community focus areas, respondents from the Northwest were less likely to indicate that opportunities for education and enrichment were an essential or very important area of focus, but respondents from the Southwest were more likely to say that education and enrichment was important.
- When asked about the importance of the City investing tax dollars into various initiatives, respondents from Central Sioux Falls were less likely to indicate that additional fire stations or public safety (Police and Fire) were essential or very important.
- Respondents from the Central District were more likely to strongly or somewhat support increased local funding for bicycle trail system expansion.
