

## 18-0158 RFP for Ash Tree Removals

### Answers to Questions 3

**1. Question:**

Would the city be okay if each of the sub-contractors working on the project carry a percentage of the total bonding needed?

**Answer:**

Since one entity is submitting the proposal, one entity must be bonded for the total proposed price.

**2. Question:**

If a parking area is barricaded as a "No Parking Zone" and someone disregards the signage & parks there anyway, can we have them towed?

**Answer:**

In the event of an abandoned vehicle in the work site, the contractor may request the assistance of law enforcement to address any violation of city ordinance.

**3. Question:**

There is the potential for a lot of snow in our work area. This snow will need to be moved to create a safe work area for our employees. If we move the snow into a pile away from our work area is this a problem?

**Answer:**

If a proposer chooses to work in a snow-covered environment, the proposer shall abide by Chapter 96 of city ordinances. Please cite Chapter 96 – Snow and Ice Removal at the link below:

**4. Question:**

If the city requires us to move the snow off site, is the city willing to pay this added fee?

**Answer:**

If the successful proposer chooses to move or remove snow from the worksite they will be responsible for any associated cost.

**5. Question:**

Since there may be snow in the work vicinity, cleaning 100% of the tree related debris will be nearly impossible. Once the snow melts will we be required to come back & re-clean tree debris? If so can this be done between Memorial Day & Labor Day?

**Answer:**

The successful proposer shall be responsible to honor all terms of the contract. The jobsite must be left in a clean and orderly manner.

**6. Question:**

Is it possible to temporarily close non arterial streets to through traffic during tree removal?

**Answer:**

If a proposer wishes to close a street, a street closure permit application must be submitted.

**7. Question:**

Will the city provide us a detailed map of the trees scheduled for removal?

**Answer:**
