Approval of Minutes of Last Meeting

A motion was made by Darrell Bren and a second was made by Dave Thompson to approve the minutes of February 2, 2011, without amendments. Yeses, 5. Noes, 0.

New Business

1. Appeal No. 2-2011. Jim Kuhle with Electric Construction Company presented pictures and the new interior of an electrical panel board he intended to modify to fit into an existing enclosure at No. 1 Penmarch Place. He stated he would have to cut approximately 5/8 inch off of both ends of the new interior mounting bracket to allow it to fit in the existing enclosure using new mounting bolts. He stated that he had contacted UL about a field evaluation and that it would cost around \$3,200 just to have them look at it, install a sticker, and leave. Don Hall presented the Electrical Board with copies of the City ordinance and Underwriters Laboratories' requirements that he used in making his decision to require this installation to have a field evaluation done by a nationally recognized testing laboratory. He felt that the integrity of the equipment requires evaluation and testing beyond that of which the City of Sioux Falls has the resources to accomplish. It is the consensus of the Electrical Board members that the installation of the modified new electrical panel board interior into an existing mounting enclosure would require a field evaluation by a nationally recognized testing laboratory.

A motion was made by Dave Thompson and a second was made by Shannon Globke to deny Appeal No. 2-2011. Yeses, 5. Noes, 0.
