**Approval of Minutes of Last Meeting**

A motion was made by Mr. Weber and a second was made by Mr. Bertsch to approve the minutes of May 11, 2011. Yeses, 3. Noes, 0.

**New Business**

1. The file was opened for Appeal No. 3-2011. Caroline Peterson of the Plum's Cooking Company requested the board review 507.2 of the 2009 IMC, to allow a residential oven with a cook top to be used for cooking classes. Mrs. Peterson stated that most of the cooking will be by the instructors and not the students and the use of butter or other grease latent vapors will be at a minimum.

A motion was made by Mr. Van Der Bill and a second was made by Mr. Bertsch. Based on the nature of the cooking and frequency, should allow a residential style hood of thirty-six inches wide and nominal six hundred CFM of exhaust to serve a residential gas or residential electric stove.
