SEASON SWIM PASSES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT ANY AQUATIC FACILITIES.

Instead of patches or wristbands, key fobs will be used for entry into aquatic facilities. All family members on a season swim pass need to have their photos taken before admission into aquatic facilities is allowed. Daily admission is charged until photo is taken.

Regular Prices

- Family: \$70 (applies to immediate family members living in the same household, including youth 18 and younger and step or foster children)
- Adult: \$45 (16–54)
- Senior: \$30 (55 and older)
- Child: \$15 (2–15)

Free Passes

Free season passes are available for qualified families who are residents of Sioux Falls who are currently enrolled in the SNAP Program (food stamps). “Family” applies to immediate family members living in the same household, including youth age 18 and younger and step or foster children. Only two people over the age of 18 in the household can be on the swim pass.

To qualify, free pass applicants must provide:

- Photo ID
- Dakota EBT Card (Food Stamp Card)
- Proof of residential/physical address (must contain your name and current address)

Reduced-Income Passes

Purchaser will receive a discount off adult/family price passes.

- Family: \$35 (applies to immediate family members living in the same household, including youth 18 and younger and step or foster children)
- Adult: \$22.50 (16 and older)

To qualify for a reduced-income swim pass, applicants must provide:

- Photo ID, PLUS one of the following:
 - South Dakota Medicaid Card
 - School District Notification Letter of Approval for free or reduced-price meals



Frequently Asked Questions about the Sioux Falls Parks and Recreation Season Swim Pass

No More Patches! No More Wristbands!

1. Why are you changing the season swim pass process?

After the initial setup, the new season swim pass system allows season swim pass holders to register online and to pay by credit or debit card. It eliminates the need to sew patches onto swim suits. It allows pool staff to deactivate and reissue lost passes quickly. It provides better tracking of pool usage to assist in the planning for new aquatics facilities for the city.

2. How do I get the new season swim pass?

Go to one of the five community centers or to the Parks and Recreation Office to register. All family members using the season swim pass will need to have their photos taken. You will be issued key fobs that will allow access to any of the City's aquatics facilities.

3. Why do I need to have photos of my family taken?

All family members on a season swim pass need to have their photos taken. This allows pool staff to identify who is authorized to use the swim pass. Key fobs will be issued upon registration, but photos must be taken before admission into aquatics facilities is allowed. Daily admission is charged until photo is taken.

4. Will I have to bring my family in every year?

Once your family's information and photos are entered into our registration system, you can renew your season swim pass online as long as you purchase a full price season pass. The key fobs are active as long as your registration is current.

5. Why can't I get the season swim pass at the pool?

The equipment needed for season swim pass registration must be used in a climate-controlled environment. The heat and humidity at aquatics facilities would cause the equipment to malfunction.

6. How many key fobs are included with the family season swim pass?

Each family member gets one key fob. Additional key fobs are \$3 each.

7. What happens if I lose a key fob?

The lost key fob will be deactivated and a new key fob will cost \$5. Replacement key fobs can be purchased at Kenny Anderson, MariCar, and Morningside Community Centers and at the Park Office.

8. Do you accept credit cards?

We accept payment by cash, check, credit card, or debit card.
