



Hello, Sioux Falls. I'm Recycling Randy and I want to tell you a little about the latest recycling ordinance that affects residential homes in Sioux Falls!

Effective January 1, 2013, Ordinance No. 53-12:

Single-stream recycling mandated! This establishes single-stream recycling for residential homes.

Recycle More!

As Haulin' Harry said, there are recyclable items banned from the landfill; however, Sioux Falls recycling facilities are able to **recycle so much more!** Our due diligence will extend the life of our landfill, protect the environment, conserve our natural resources, and save money!

Who is subject to this ordinance?

All residential homes to include apartment buildings (multi-housing). Owners of these facilities must provide adequate single-stream containers for recyclables and provide recycling service along with garbage service.

Let's recycle and do our part to leave our kids and our grandkids with a better place to live.





I am Haulin' Harry. Here is some information to assist in the single-stream recycling change!

Is my garbage hauler held accountable for recycling?

Yes. Every licensed hauler must provide single-stream collection at least twice a month when servicing residential homes. They must also meet a specific recycling rate percentage, so the more you recycle the more you help your hauler.

What is single-stream recycling?

This means that accepted *recyclable materials* will all be placed *in one sealed container* but kept *separate from your garbage*. If you are not receiving single-stream recycling service from your hauler, please contact your garbage hauler or the City.

- Office paper
- Corrugated cardboard
- Plastic containers (#1 and #2)
- Metal containers
- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Bulk-rate mail

These items are banned from the Landfill and must be recycled!
